- Don't second guess...trust yourself.

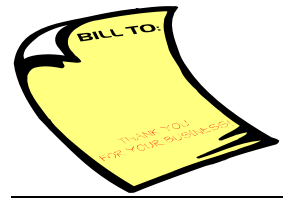

Morning Care / Academic Enrichment Payments:



April payment is due by the 10th of the month. All additional payments are also due on the 10th of each month. A late fee will be applied to any payment received after the 10th of that month.

Morning care fees: \$95.00 per month or \$15.00 per day. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:30 am for this program. Breakfast is included.

Academic Enrichment Program fees: \$165.00 per month or \$25.00 per day. Snack is provided along with homework help, tutoring when needed, an educational activity and some recess time. Students must be picked up no later than 6:00 pm. Any student not picked up by 6:00 pm, a \$25.00 fee will be charged plus \$1.00 per minute after that.
