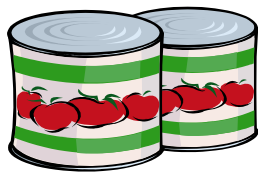
Feeding Florida

- Feeding Florida has designated priority items.
- The following list must be distributed to parents:
 - canned fruit (no sugar added)
 - canned vegetables and beans
 - canned meat or poultry
 - rice, pasta and dry beans
 - nonfat dry milk
 - granola bars
 - powdered infant milk
 - baby food (no glass)
 - peanut butter and jelly (no glass)

Please Note: We cannot accept items in glass containers, perishable food items, home canned or home baked goods. Also, make sure to check the expiration date on all items. Any expired items will not be collected.

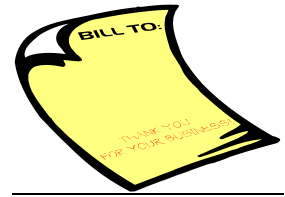
At the end of the Food Drive the top 2 classes with the most weighed items will win a pizza celebration.

Reminders:

Morning Care / Academic Enrichment Payments:



November payment is due by the 1st of the month. All additional payments are also due on the 1st of each month. A late fee will be applied to any payment received after the 10th of that month.

Morning care fees: \$95.00 per month or \$15.00 per day. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:30 am for this program. Breakfast is included.

Academic Enrichment Program fees: \$165.00 per month or \$25.00 per day. Snack is provided along with homework help, tutoring when needed, an educational activity and some recess time. Students must be picked up no later than 6:00 pm. Any student not picked up by 6:00 pm, a \$25.00 fee will be charged plus \$1.00 per minute after that.
